



Fisher House Foundation Scholarship Programs

Fisher House Foundation (FHF), a 501(c)(3), administers the Heroes' Legacy and Scholarships for Military Children Scholarship programs and hosts Scholarships for Service, a free scholarship search tool. These programs offer investment opportunities to make a profound impact in the lives of the children of our nation's heroes. Fisher House Foundation is seeking sponsors to increase award recipients and amounts and underwrite the administration of Scholarships for Service.

Heroes' Legacy Scholarship Since 2011, the number of recipients has grown from 24 to 677, with nearly \$11 million awarded. Award amounts are determined by the number of applicants and the contributions received each year. For 2021, \$2,000 was awarded per student.*

- Eligibility**
- Military dependents under the age of 23
 - Full-time enrollment in a four-year or two-year U.S. credited undergraduate college or university
 - Minimum applicant cumulative GPA on a 4.0 basis: HS = 3.0, College = 2.5
 - Child of a service member who died, or is 100% disabled, with post-September 11, 2001 military service

Scholarships for Military Children Through the generosity of sponsors, more than 12,000 students have been awarded over \$21 million in scholarships. Fisher House Foundation awards \$1 million annually to 500 recipients, selected from thousands of applicants. Awards are \$2,000 each.*

- Eligibility**
- Military dependents under the age of 23
 - Full-time enrollment in a four-year or two-year U.S. credited undergraduate college or university
 - Minimum applicant cumulative GPA on a 4.0 basis: HS = 3.0, College = 2.5
